1. Position

- 1 position: Thai Instructor for Bachelor of Arts Program in Journalism (Media Studies) or B.J.M. Program, Faculty of Journalism and Mass Communication
- Salary
Master's Degree graduate (Ph.D. candidate): 27,130 – 40,690 Baht
Ph. D's Degree graduate: 35,700 – 53,550 Baht

2. Job Requirement

- The successful candidate must be approved by the university executive committees.
- The successful candidate must be able to work at Faculty of Journalism and Mass Communication, Rangsit Campus.

3. Applicant Qualifications

3.1 General Qualifications

3.1.1 The applicant's qualifications must follow Rule 2 No. 11, Thammasat University's Human Resource Management Regulations 2016.

3.1.2 Have good behavior

3.2 Specific Qualifications

3.2.1 Ph.D. graduate or Ph.D. candidate in Journalism, Mass Communication, Communication Arts, or related field

3.2.2 Have Ph.D. Thesis or have experience in Journalism, Mass Communication, Communication Arts, or related field

3.2.3 Preference will be given to candidates who expert in research methodology or have experience in journalism or new media field.

3.2.4 Graduated from university or institute that office of the civil service commission or Office of the Teacher Civil Service and Educational Personnel approved.

The applicant will exclude from 3.2.1 and 3.2.2 if he/she have Thailand academic rank (assistant professor position onwards). The academic rank must be appointed in accordance with the rules and university's academic rank for full-time position approach or the announcement of Teacher Civil Service and Educational Personnel.

Rules and approach to verify the applicant's academic rank will be consider by the Academic Rank Committee's decision.

3.2.5 Obtained an English proficiency test score of one of the following types within 3 years up to the date of application:

If the applicant got the English Proficiency Score lower than No. 3.2.5, the faculty might propose the committee to approve the qualified candidate on a case by case basis. In this case, the faculty must consider that the successful candidate have potential to acquire the English Score as mentioned in 3.2.5. The successful candidate must take the English Test and get the English Proficiency Score specified in 3.2.5 within 2 years from the first day of the contract. If the successful candidate cannot obtained the English proficiency score as specified in 3.2.5 on time, he/she will be withdraw from the university's position.

The applicant who possess these qualifications does not need to obtain the English proficiency score from 3.2.5:

- Graduated from International or English Program which Office of the Civil Service Commission or Office of the Teacher Civil Service and Educational Personnel approved.

4.2 Required Documents for Applications (All the documents must be submit within the deadline otherwise the application is deemed to be withdrawn)

4.2.1 A copy of graduation certificate/ degree certificate, and a copy of transcript. Please bring the original ones to declare on the application day. In case that all documents are not in English or Thai, the applicant must bring the translated ones along with the translation certified documents.

4.2.2 An English Proficiency Test Score

4.2.3 A copy of House Registration and a copy of Identification Card (the original one need to declare on the application day)

4.2.4 A copy of names and surnames change, if any.

4.2.5 Two photos with no hat and no glasses, sized 1 inch or 2 inches. The photos must have been taken no longer than one year.

4.2.6 Medical certificate (original one) which has been issued no longer than 6 months until the application day. The certificate must show that the applicant does not suffer from:

- 1) Leprosy
- 2) Tuberculosis
- 3) Drug Addiction
- 4) Alcoholism
- 5) Chronic renal failure
- 6) Alzheimer's disease
- 7) Insane or mentally sick
- 8) Pestilence or chronic disease

5.1 Moral, Ethics and EQ

5.1.1 Applicants must possess university lecturer's moral and ethics.

5.1.2 Applicants must test EQ, Psychology and Attitude Test. The characteristics that suitable for working include:

- 1) Have stable mind eg. be assertive, be patient and can cope with difficult situation and act properly.
- 2) Be nice and friendly eg. be trustworthy, honest and open-minded as well as have the ability to work as a team.
- 3) Have the ability to adapt themselves with the new environment.
