



Announcement of Faculty of Journalism and Mass Communication
On the Call for Applications: Faculty Position (Faculty of Journalism and Mass
Communication) No. 3/2022

The Faculty of Journalism and Mass Communication, Thammasat University opens the call for applications for qualified individuals to apply for a faculty position (in the Faculty of Journalism and Masa Communication) **in the Bachelor of Arts Program in Journalism (Media Studies) (international program) (B.J.M. Program)**. The application information is as follows:

1. Recruiting position

- International faculty in the Bachelor of Arts Program in Journalism (Media Studies) (international program) (B.J.M. Program): 1 position
- Payment Rates:
Applied with a master's degree (is completing a doctoral degree): 28,630 - 57,260 baht
Applied with a doctoral degree: 41,000 - 82,000 baht

2. Position terms

- 2.1 The successful candidate selected by the Faculty of Journalism and Mass Communication will be appointed subsequent to the approval of the University
- 2.2 The successful candidate must be able to perform their duties at Thammasat University: Tha Prachan and Rangsit Campuses
- 2.3 Have ability to teach and advise students in both theoretical and practical aspects

3. Applicant qualifications

3.1 General qualifications:

- 3.1.1 Meet the requirements as per stated in Section 2, Number 11 of Thammasat University Regulation on Human Resources Management of University Employees 2559 B.E. (2016)
- 3.1.2 Be of good moral character

3.2 Specific qualifications

- 3.2.1 Hold a doctoral or equivalent degree or having passed the Ph.D. candidacy examination and is completing a doctoral degree in

Journalism, Communication Arts, Mass Communication, or a specialization related to communication

- 3.2.2 Have published a doctoral dissertation or have past experience working in the field of Journalism, Communication Arts, Mass Communication, or a field related to communication
- 3.2.3 Having demonstrated ability and knowledge in research methodology or past experience working in the Journalism field or strategic communication will be given special consideration
- 3.2.4 Graduated from a university or educational institute accredited by the Civil Service Commission (CSC) or the Civil Service Commission in Higher Education

In case an applicant has been appointed an academic rank of Assistant Professor or above in accordance with standard academic rank appointment requirements, which follow University Regulation on Criteria and Procedures for Academic Rank Appointment for Full-time Faculty or Announcement of the Civil Service Commission in Higher Education on Criteria and Procedures for Academic Rank Appointment for Full-time Faculty, the applicant may be exempted from job specification number 3.2.1 and 3.2.2.

Verification of academic rank criteria and appointment shall be as approved by the Academic Rank Committee.

- 3.2.5 Have proof of one of the following English language proficiency test scores; the score must be no older than three years counting from the day the test took place to the day of the application:
 - 1) TOEFL
 - Paper Based 550 points and above
 - Computer Based 213 points and above
 - Internet Based 79 points and above
 - 2) IELTS 6.5 points and above
 - 3) TU-GET 550 points and above
 - 4) CU-TEP 75 points and above

In case the successful candidate fails to meet a required minimum score as stipulated in number 3.2.5, but the Faculty decides that the candidate has potential to pass a required minimum score, the Faculty may propose to the Selection Committee to consider appointing and hiring the candidate. However, the candidate must then pass a minimum score as stipulated in number 3.2.5 within two years counting from the

employment date. If the candidate fails to pass a minimum score by the deadline, the employment will be terminated.

Applicants with the following qualities do not need to submit proof of English language proficiency as stipulated in number 3.2.5:

- Graduated from an international program or a program conducted in English; accredited by CSC or the Civil Service Commission in Higher Education

4. Application

4.1 The applicant must submit the application form and required evidence in-person at the Faculty Secretary Office, 3rd floor, Faculty of Journalism and Mass Communication, Thammasat University, Rangsit Campus, Pathumthani; **from now until October 31st, 2022** during office hours. 4.2 Required evidence (the applicant must submit all required documents and evidence by the application deadline) including:

4.2.1 A copy of degree certificate and transcript (please also bring the originals). If the documents are not in Thai or English, applicants must attach a certified English translation

4.2.2 English language proficiency test score

4.2.3 A copy of house registration and a copy of National ID Card

4.2.4 A copy of name or last name change evidence (if any)

4.2.5 Two photos with no hat and no sunglasses on; 1 or 2 inches in size; no older than one year (counting until the application deadline)

4.2.6 Medical certificate issued within the last six months; the applicant must have been examined and certified by a doctor to be free of the following diseases:

- 1) Tuberculosis in the contagious stage
- 2) Elephantiasis with obvious visible disfiguring
- 3) Drug addiction
- 4) Alcoholism
- 5) Chronic kidney disease
- 6) Dementia
- 7) Mental disorder with obvious or severe symptoms and interfering with work performance

- 8) Dangerous communicable disease or chronic disease with obvious or severe symptoms and interfering with work performance

4.2.7 Academic work and details of relevant experiences or special skills.
The documents will be returned subsequently to the selection.

5. Selection criteria

5.1 Ethical, moral, and emotional intelligence

5.1.1 The applicant must be of good ethical and moral character in accordance with the code of conduct of the University faculty

5.1.2 The applicant must provide results from an emotional intelligence test and assessments of mental health and desirable job candidate attributes. The desirable job candidate attributes include:

- 1) Emotional stability such as showing determination, endurance, ability to handle difficult situations and perform under pressure
- 2) Amiable disposition such as trusting, sincere, open-minded, and team player
- 3) Adaptability, having no irrational anxiety or fear

For the assessments in number 5.1.2., the applicant shall take a mental health assessment and emotional intelligence test at Thammasat University Hospital or another department of the University as approved by the Selection Committee. The applicant may be interviewed, asked to complete a survey or other forms of assessment as the Selection Committee sees fit.

The screening of the applications and selection of the faculty are at the discretion of the Faculty of Journalism and Mass Communication with fair and non-discriminatory reasoning and without prejudices based on gender, age, or religion. A successful candidate will be selected based on their knowledge, skills, attitude, personality, and suitability for the position.
